Second Literary Memorial of Giorgos Mavrogenis	The Library of the Cyprus University of Technology (CUT), in collaboration with the Mavrogenis Cultural Foundation and the Patticheio Historical Archive and Research Centre, organised the event “Second Literary Memorial” honouring the renowned Cypriot cartoonist Giorgos Mavrogenis (1928–2019). The event included the opening of an exhibition of his original caricatures and presentations highlighting his artistic and cultural legacy. Participants also presented the digitised archive of the satirical newspaper <i>I Satiriki</i> , undertaken by the CUT Library Digitisation Lab, which preserves 618 issues published between 1964 and 1985. Library tours and educational programmes	<p>The Library welcomes visits from organized groups, including local schools (primary and secondary education students), and visitors. In 2025 the Library accepted 22 tours (381 persons) and 26 educational programmes (551 persons). These visits provide students with insights into academic library services and a tour of the facilities. Event “100 years of Mikis Theodorakis”	The CUT Library organised a commemorative event dedicated to the life and work of the renowned Greek composer Mikis Theodorakis, marking the centenary of his birth. The event, co-organised with writer Elli Paionidis and the Cyprus Radio Foundation, featured speeches, musical performances of Theodorakis’ works and reflections from prominent figures of literature and the arts. A special message from singer George Dalaras and the participation of the Limassol Music School “Marios Tokas” enriched the programme. The event also included the opening of an exhibition with archival material from the Elli and Panikos Paionidis Archive, highlighting the composer’s cultural legacy and long-standing connections with Cyprus. <p>Event “In the Footsteps of Truth: The Imprint of Kostas Gennaris”</p>	<p>The CUT Library organised an event to present the collection of journalist and writer Kostas Gennaris and inaugurate the dedicated space hosting the collection. The archive, donated by his family, includes approximately 2,500 books and printed materials related mainly to the Cyprus issue, journalism and communication, as well as more than 2,000 historical documents.
