Inter-Institutional Agreement

- •By signing an inter-institutional agreement, the involved institutions agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and / or staff in the context of Erasmus+.
- HEIs agree on a series of quantitative and qualitative issues to ensure mobility of high quality and impact.

Learning and Training Agreement

•A "Learning or Training Agreement" is setting out the programme of studies/traineeship to be followed and is approved by the student, the sending and the receiving institution/enterprise.






